## Jesus and Simon Peter

<sup>4</sup> When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into the deep water and let down your nets for a catch." <sup>5</sup> Simon answered, "Master, we have worked all night long but have caught nothing. Yet if you say so, I will let down the nets." 6 When they had done this, they caught so many fish that their nets were beginning to break. <sup>7</sup>So they signaled their partners in the other boat to come and help them. And they came and filled both boats, so that they began to sink. 8 But when Simon Peter saw it, he fell down at Jesus' knees, saying, "Go away from me, Lord, for I am a sinful man!" 9 For he and all who were with him were amazed at the

catch of fish that they had taken; 10 and so also were James and John, sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. Then Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid; from now on you will be catching people." -Luke 5:4-10

A disciple is a person who embraces and assists in spreading the teachings of another. That's what Jesus' disciples do. They help Jesus share his teachings with others. But how does Jesus get his disciples? He calls them.

On Sunday I want to tell you Simon Peter's call story. I have to warn you that Jesus calls normal people like you to share in his work in the world. Jesus calls people like you to fish for people. Jesus calls people like you to shine light in the darkness. Jesus calls people like you to make disciples of Jesus Christ, teaching them to obey everything that he has taught us. He calls people like you to feed the hungry, welcome the stranger, clothe the naked, care for the sick, and visit the prisoner.

I'll let you in on a little secret: pastors love call stories. We love to tell our own call stories, and we love to tell the call stories in the Bible. Why do we love them so much? Well, I suppose it's because we know what it's like to hear a call from God and attempt to answer that call. And so, we just love to watch God call people like you to do ministries you never dreamed you would do. We just love watching God take over your priorities and your desires. And we just love it when Jesus calls you to fish for people.

When Jesus calls, I'm sure most of you are prepared with an excuse. "Go away from me Jesus, for I am a sinful person." "I wouldn't know what to say." "No one will believe me." "I don't speak well." But still Jesus persists, "Do not be afraid. From now on you'll be fishing for people."

This is how Jesus intends to change the world... by calling people into the kingdom of God and inviting them to repent. It is about changing the world. It is about fixing and restoring the world. Everything Jesus did was to illustrate that. In the kingdom of God, hungry students get fed on the weekends. In the kingdom of God, people stuck in sin and addiction get freed and healed. In the kingdom of God, people who feel unlovable experience God's love and the love of God's people. In the end, the mission of Jesus only works if his followers will fish for people.

I hope you will invite someone you know to worship with us on Sunday at 8:30 or 10:50 as we continue our Jesus and You sermon series. Have a great week, and I will see you on Sunday.




We would love for you to join us for in person worship on Sunday mornings at 8:30 or 10:50.
