That You May Believe

¹⁹ When it was evening on that day, the first day of the week, and the doors of the house where the disciples had met were locked for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." ²⁰ After he said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. ²¹ Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." ²² When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit. ²³ If you forgive the sins of any, they are forgiven them; if you retain the sins of any, they are retained." ²⁴ But

Thomas (who was called the Twin), one of the twelve, was not with them when Jesus came. ²⁵ So the other disciples told him, "We have seen the Lord." But he said to them, "Unless I see the mark of the nails in his hands, and put my finger in the mark of the nails and my hand in his side, I will not believe." -John 20:19-25

No one believed in the resurrection at first. When Mary Magdalene told the disciples, "I have seen the Lord," they fearfully locked themselves behind closed doors. Can you imagine what it was like when Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." I bet it was awesome. Then he breathed on them and gave them the gift of the Holy Spirit. Don't you wish you had been there that day? I am sure Thomas did. Can you imagine what it was like to miss out on such a life-changing moment?
